

Eduroam is a global wireless network service for research and education. An eligible organization (research organization or education-related organization) can provide users (students, staff and faculty) with wireless access at participating institutions through the use of their home institution credentials.

The service has two main components:

1. It offers ALBA students, faculty, and staff access to authenticated and encrypted Wifi access when on the campuses of the thousands of other college campuses in the world that support eduroam. Locally BALAMAND, AUB, USEK, NDU, LAU and USJ support eduroam.
2. It gives students, faculty, and staff of other eduroam enabled institutions access to an authenticated and encrypted Wifi network while they are visiting ALBA premises.

Getting Connected

It is easy to connect to eduroam – when visiting an institution that supports eduroam, you simply need to enter your ALBA email address as username and your ALBA email password. Once you have entered and saved your login credentials on your device, you will be able to automatically connect to the eduroam network whenever it is available.

Access For eduroam Visitors

Visiting students, faculty, and staff from participating eduroam organizations are able to securely access the eduroam wireless network on the ALBA campus using their **home organization's credentials**. This network is an enhanced alternative to ALBA-GUEST for individuals coming from another eduroam campus, as there is no time limit for accessing eduroam.
